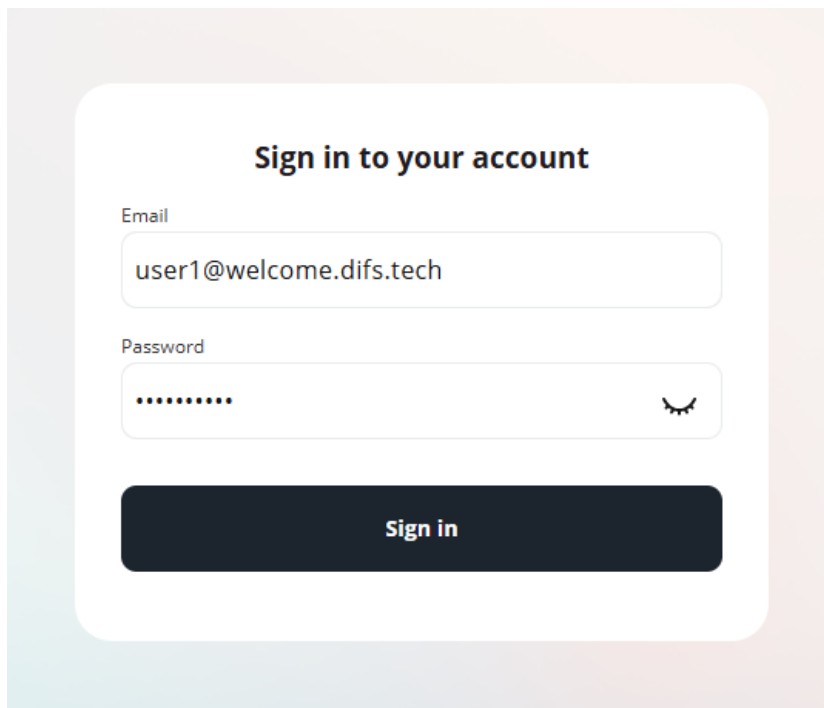


# **User instructions for logging into the welcome.difs.tech using two-factor authentication (2FA)**

Two-factor authentication (2FA) is used to log in. It adds a second level of protection: after entering your username and password, the system will ask for a one-time code that is generated on your smartphone.

### **Access to the welcome.difs.tech**

1. Go to the website: <https://pwa.welcome.difs.tech/>
2. In the window that opens, enter:
  - Email
  - Password
3. Press Sign in



### **How to enable two-factor authentication (2FA)**

You can use the Google Authenticator application or any other application for two-factor authentication.

1. Download and install the selected application on your phone.
2. Launch it. For the first time, the app may ask for permission to use the camera. Allow me, this is necessary to scan the QR code.
3. Press the "+" button in the application.

4. Select "Scan QR Code".
5. Point your phone's camera at the QR code on your computer screen. Hold the phone still until the app recognizes the code.
6. After scanning, a new entry will appear in the application with the name of the service and a six-digit code, which is updated every 30 seconds.

### **Confirm the setting**

1. After scanning the QR code, a field for entering the code will appear on the computer screen.
2. Look at the phone — the current six-digit code is displayed there.
3. Enter this code on your computer and click "Submit".

### Connect 2FA application

1) Install any 2FA application  
(e.g. FreeOTP, Superdigital Authenticator)

2) Open the app and scan QR code

and click Submit to finish the setup
